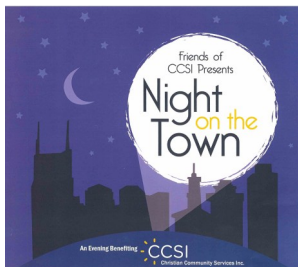
Theresa Blanford and Adam Jones
