"Kid's Faith: Finding It, or Losing It?"

Karyn Henley an award-winning author and children’s communicator will present a workshop at Brentwood Hills April 20th-23rd. The workshop will be for our parents and our teachers. Mark your calendars and begin planning for this workshop. More information and registration forms will be available in the near future.

Karyn Henley is best known as the author of the original *Beginner's Bible*, which has sold more than 3 million copies, and *God's Story*, a chronological Bible for young readers ages 6 to 12. In 1997 Karyn was honored by Children's Pastors' Conference with the "Excellence in Children's Ministry" Award in recognition of her long-term commitment to children's ministry. Karyn's career as a teacher and author began at the age of 14 when she was asked by her mother to teach a class of 18-month-old children. Thirty years later her Child Talk™ Seminars for parents and teachers are popular events at churches in the United States and abroad, as are her PLAYSONGS™ concerts. Karyn is a graduate of Abilene Christian University.

Our children and youth ministries in conjunction with our Family Life Cluster will be organizing and hosting this workshop. The program will be in our Family Life Center on Sunday April 20th from 3:30 until 6:00 pm; Monday and Tuesday April 21st and 22nd the sessions will be from 6:30 pm until 8:30 pm each evening and Wednesday April 23rd the session will be during our mid-week service time beginning at 6:30 pm.

Topics for the workshop will include: Planting and Growing Faith and Morals; Where We are Today (Postmodernism); I want to believe but I can't; Do your kids know why they believe?; Why should I buy Christianity?; If God is good, Why Do We Suffer?? Admission will be FREE to the workshop---but you must register for child care! Forms and more information will be posted on our website www.brentwoodhills.org and in the foyer.

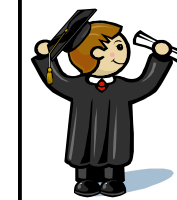
