SPRING BREAK TRIP TO HONDURAS

A group of 13 university students & adults from Brentwood Hills went on a ten day Spring Break mission trip to Honduras. We traveled by plane to Tegucigalpa, Honduras on Friday, March 14th. We stayed in dorms and ate many of our meals in the cafeteria at Baxter Institute. We prepared sack lunches for days when we traveled. On Saturday, March 15th, the BHCC team went with leaders from the Kennedy church and visited in many of the homes of Kennedy church families. On Sunday, March 16th, we attended Bible class & the morning service at the Kennedy church. Then the BHCC team and Alcides & Ruth Lucena hosted a two hour VBS for about 75 children at the Kennedy church. Later we prepared 70 food bags for Limoncillo.

On Monday, March 17th, our BHCC team along with Alcides, Ruth and Cielo Lucena, Gary and Disel (from the Cartagena, Columbia mission team) traveled by bus to Limoncillo, Honduras. Ronald & Daisy Million & their two daughters met us at Limoncillo. We hosted a two hour VBS with Bible skits, Bible story activities and games for about 60 children at the Limoncillo church. After the VBS we handed out 70 food bags to the church families and played more games with the children. On Tuesday, March 18th, we traveled by bus to the Valley of Angels for a day of fellowship with German, Ronnie & Nahum & his 2 grandchildren from the Kennedy church. After we returned to Baxter Institute on Tuesday afternoon we bagged beans, rice, sugar, etc. and assembled forty large food bags to take to La Cienega on Saturday. On Wednesday morning, March 19th, the BHCC mission team, Alcides, Ruth and Cielo, Gary, Marvin & Evelyn (from the Cartagena, Columbia mission team), Nahum & his two grandchildren (from the Kennedy church), the bus driver & his wife loaded our things on the bus and made a four hour trip to the Mission Lazarus Ranch near Cholulteca, Honduras. Jarrod & Ali Brown welcomed us when we arrived. On Wednesday afternoon, March 19th, the BHCC mission team and the Cartagena, Columbia mission team worked together moving rocks, shoveling mulch & spreading mulch on a large playground for the orphaned children at Mission Lazarus. After supper Jarrod Brown told us about the work being done at Mission Lazarus. We spent Wednesday night and Thursday night in cabins on the Mission Lazarus Ranch. On Thursday morning, March 20th, the BHCC team traveled to a remote village to host a two hour VBS for 55 children. On Thursday afternoon the BHCC team worked for over four hours shoveling rocks and dirt to help build a 50 foot sewage drainage ditch for the three group homes at Mission Lazarus. Staying together in cabins, eating all of our meals together, working together & traveling on the bus together for many hours with the Cartagena, Columbia team provided us with the opportunity to really get to know Alcides, Ruth, Cielo, Gary, Disel, Marvin & Evelyn. We shared stories, had many conversations and laughed a lot. On Friday, March 21st, we made the four hour trip back to Baxter Institute in Tegucigalpa. Late Friday afternoon the BHCC team prepared VBS materials, stuffed candy in 250 plastic Easter eggs and made up sack lunches for Saturday. On Saturday, March 22nd, the BHCC team, Alcides, Ruth, Cielo, Gary & Disel (Columbia mission team) and 12 members of the Kennedy church loaded on the bus and went to La Cienega, Honduras to host our fourth and final VBS for about 80 children. After the VBS we had an Easter egg & toy hunt for the children. We handed out 40 large food bags to the church families. The guys from BHCC, Kennedy church & La Cienega church played soccer. On Saturday afternoon we returned to Baxter Institute. On Saturday night the BHCC team took Alcides, Ruth, Cielo, Gary & Disel (Columbia team), Amber Foster (a U.S. missionary who helped us make all of our travel arrangements), Amber's "adopted" son and Marcos "Bookie" (our bus driver) out to eat at Friday's. On Sunday, March 23rd, Alcides, Ruth, Cielo, Ronald & Daisy Million, German, Nahum, Ronnie, Amber and others went with us to the airport. We shared many hugs and said good-bye to our brothers and sisters. After some delays we arrived back at Brentwood Hills at 2:00 a.m. on Monday, March 24th with many good memories of our Spring Break Trip to Honduras. We love the members of the Cartagena, Columbia mission team, and we look forward to working with them again in the future.
