"CONNECT" BEGINS ON MAY 7TH

"CONNECT", a new format for Bible study and fellowship for young, single adults in the area will begin at BHCC on May 7th. Every Wednesday night there will be several options for single adults. In addition to the 5:45p.m. P.O.W.E.R. class in the auditorium for all ages and other adult classes at 6:30 p.m., THERE WILL BE TWO NEW OPTIONS for young, single adults beginning May 7th and continuing until August. From 6:15p.m. - 7:00p.m. a meal for young, single adults will be served on the terrace or in the terrace view room (classroom #502). The cost for the meal including a drink and a dessert will be \$5.00 per person. Each person who attends the meal will receive a colored number and will be seated along with 6-8 other people at the red, blue, green or yellow table. Each week during the summer everyone who attends will mix with a different group of people for the meal and have the opportunity to share 4-6 informational facts about themselves, so they can get to know and CONNECT with other young, single adults from the area. After the meal from 7:00-7:45 p.m. all of the single adults will divide up into 2 smaller groups for a period of singing and Bible study. There will be one Bible study group for single adults (target age 26 - 40) on the subject "Relationships". There will also be a group for single adults (target age 19-29). Johnsie Henderson and several others will be leading this Bible study group on the subject "Twenty Something Issues". Some of the subjects to be discussed in this group include: "Rude Awakenings: Why was I in such a hurry to grow up?" "Life in the real world: Making decisions, making payments, making it to work or class on time, etc." "Who do I call when I need help?" "Should I put major decisions on hold until I graduate from college and/or until I find someone to marry?" "What about on-line dating?" "Feeling alone in a crowded city" "Developing and maintaining covenant relationships", etc.

"Go, De..."

In the Mission's Team 2007 year-end report received from Venezuela, it is evident that God is alive and well in their efforts! Leo Rojas reports that the congregation in Barquismeto had 85 baptisms in 2007. The Barquismeto congregation has also been very active with marriage ministry and single programs, men's retreats, along with working and planning on their new building. They also established a new congregation in Nirgua, one hour from Barquismeto, where they had seven baptisms and there are 15-20 people meeting on Sundays. Much success has been reported between the very active congregations in Yaritagua, Chivacoa, Nirgu, Santa Inés, Quibor, Duaca, and Carora with 50 baptisms between them fueled by very committed and excited preachers. 2008 goals for the congregations in Venezuela include establishing a new church, baptizing over 200 people, moving into their new Barquismeto building, establishing a church in a nearby prison, holding more marriage conferences, supporting and helping with the new work in Cartagena and "many, many more things". Please keep this work in your prayers as they facilitate our efforts in Venezuela to "...go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature". — Shawn Humphrey
