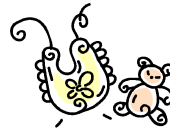

## "Go, Be..."

Update from World Christian Broadcasting (WCB) - WCB is preparing to cover the world with the Gospel! Currently, WCB is having three 100,000 watt transmitters being built where they will be used at their new station in the Indian Ocean. These transmitters will power nine acres of wire hanging in the air and will daily cover Africa, South America, the Middle East, India, Indonesia, the European part of Russia, and the southern and eastern sections of China with the gospel. In addition to the three large antennas, one directional antenna will cover the countries in the Indian Ocean. A separate station in Alaska reaches two-thirds of Russia and China and countries in the Pacific Rim. Every day, twenty hours of broadcasting is heard in the Russian, Chinese and English languages. Listeners have responded to WCB literally from the entire world. Between the two stations, the gospel will be available to almost 5 billion people everyday. Please be prayerful about WCB's new Indian Ocean station as we "... go into all the world to preach the gospel to every creature".
