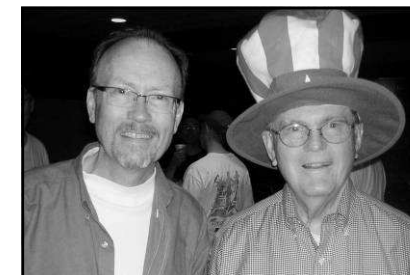
**Lovely Evening 2008**
