Shannon Sarver Brown---the granddaughter of **Carl** and **Joyce McKelvey** and the niece of **Roberto** and **Ginger Santiago**---is married to **Major Charles Brown**, who is now serving his 5th deployment with the U.S. Army. Three of which have been in **Afghanistan**. His Captain had a dream for **6,000** care packages to be mailed to his unit for **Father's Day**. At first, shoe-box type boxes were being planned that would contain many small items, an encouraging note and a beanie baby type toy that the soldiers could give to the children. This week they are now trying to fill backpacks with the personal items and toys. Why backpacks? By using children's backpacks, we are giving the gift of giving---the soldiers can re-gift the bags to the children. Many of the children are afraid of the soldiers---and the toys and backpacks will help them develop trusting relationships. **Shannon** undertook the project by committing to **200** backpacks---by asking relatives and friends to support the effort. Her home congregation, the **Madison Church of Christ**---got behind the project and they are now asking other churches to help out! Their goal now is **6000** backpacks. The main problem---an early deadline---the boxes must be mailed by May 24th, so all of the supplies need to be collected by May 21st. We have posted the information about the project on our web site and information sheets are available in the foyer if you would like to fill a backpack or collect some of the items. The members of the **504th Infantry Unit** from **Fort Campbell** will be stationed in Afghanistan for the next 14 months. You can fill a backpack with the suggested items, include a note of encouragement (please do not include political preference, but rather how much you appreciate the soldiers and their sacrifices, etc) It will cost nearly \$5.50 in postage to mail the bags. There are several drop-off locations including our Grandview building. If you can fill a backpack or you have items to send---bring them to our building and we will deliver to Grandview. If you can give us a check to help with postage that will be great! Deadline is Wednesday May 21st.

Shannon is expecting their third child...who will be nearly a year old when her husband returns.
