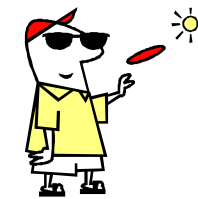
"Go De..."

Update on our Mission efforts in Guatemala - Great strides are being made for the Lord in Guatemala! In the first quarter of 2008, Health Talents International (HTI) was able to provide medical care for more than **9,000** patients and perform more than 200 surgeries in Guatemala. Directly related to the medical care that was provided to the indigenous Mayan population, there was an increase in church attendance in local churches of Christ and more than **10** ten baptisms. To date, the HTI leadership team now includes 19 physicians, nurses, dentists, evangelists, and administrative staff. Dr. Kendall Yates recently lead a surgery team of mostly BHCC members in January. Engineering teams from Lipscomb University and the University of Tennessee have made large impacts by recently building water collection and purification systems in some of the poorest villages in Guatemala allowing a life-changing, healthy alternative to the bacteria infested water they have depended on for years. Additionally, professors from UT are also involved in a 2-3 year project to determine ways to curb chicken loss to disease and to increase output in agriculture. 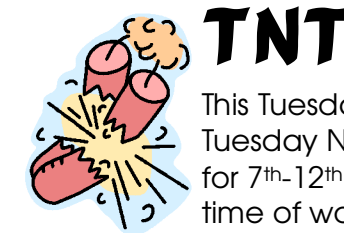
