

Family Meeting this Sunday at 6:00 pm

We are **Family**. We are a community of believers. Our shepherds are committed to providing the best “spiritual atmosphere” as we all continue on our **Journey** to the **Son**.

Besides providing the **tools** for our **spiritual growth**...the elders want to make sure that our **facilities** and **personnel** are providing a **safe** and **secure** atmosphere for each of us as we attend worship and other functions at our campus.

Over the next few months, some of you may be asked to serve on special committees to help **review**, **evaluate**, and **suggest** changes to our **policies** and **procedures**. We will be implementing some new **guidelines** and making some changes that will help make our campus safer for all ages.

The elders have announced that we are going to put up an additional fence, which will close-in the lawn area in front of the children’s wing. This will mean that our two playground areas and this grass area will all be secured by a fence. We are also making repairs to the gates and the fence along the back side of our property. We hope this will provide a safer and more secure area for our children.

However, this does mean that we don’t have a responsibility to supervise our children in the **Family Life Center**, the **playgrounds**, and the **lawn area**. Our teachers are being instructed that if they are taking children outside, they are to stay within the fenced-in areas. After services, when we have free-play, parents will need to supervise the area and the children.

Brent Terry is designing and helping to order the materials. Once we receive our permit from the **City of Oak Hill**, order the material, and can establish a time-line, we will announce a work day for members to help with the installation of the fence.

We need to be mindful of all of our members. Our children need to be cautioned about running in the halls and the foyer---to avoid running into our older members. We all need to be alert in the parking lots---to watch our speed and to be careful as we back-up or pull through the lots.

Another critical issue facing our family---is our **SPACE ISSUE**. We have been studying and analyzing our parking, our facility, our attendance, etc for the past several months.

This **Sunday Night---June 22nd**—our elders will host at **Family Meeting** to present some of the findings from our study. **Doug Akers**, from **LifeWay**, will be here to make the presentation. We will have a short devotional at **6:00 pm** to be followed by Doug’s presentation. We encourage all families to attend. We know this is short notice, but with **camp** and other **summer** activities during the next few weeks---we wanted to have this initial meeting as soon as possible. jfs

Connect Meal and Bible Study on Wednesdays

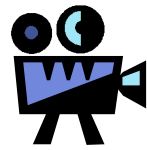

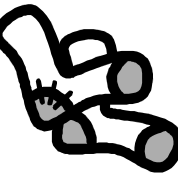
Hendersonville Trip
