

We will spend the afternoon getting the camp ready for our first week. Several of us will be spending **Saturday** night and others will arrive on **Sunday** morning to make sure that we have everything ready to go for camp.

We will have a morning worship service at camp, beginning at 10:30 am. Meanwhile, at **Brentwood Hills**, we will be giving out "prayer cards"---with the name of a camper or staff member that you can pray for next week. 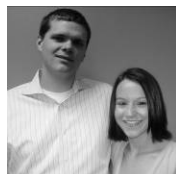
