Elders Seek Godly Wisdom Through Prayer and Fasting

On the evening of July 25th, the elders and their wives are meeting for a season of prayer following a day of fasting. Because of the many issues that Brentwood Hills is facing at this time, we felt it important to ask for wisdom from God and focus our attention on our leadership role as shepherds of this congregation. As a cluster coordinator, we are soliciting your help in contacting deacons within your cluster and arranging for those that are available to also meet at your home (or one of the other deacon's home or the church) on or before that date to pray for us as we seek God's will in selecting the proper course of action. We know that not all will be able to attend. However, if each of you are collectively able to have 20 to 30 deacons praying for us it would be deeply appreciated. Specific topics include wisdom in selecting a song leader for our congregation; guidance as we seek to either expand our classroom space, make better use of our facilities, or plant churches, etc. We also pray that God will continue to bless us as a body with unity and that each member will find a place in our body where they can be transformed into the likeness of Christ.



Follow in His Steps — "Day to Day Wisdom"

Our summer adult Sunday School series continues this Sunday, July 27 with a combined class in the main auditorium at 9:15 a.m. **Dr. Terry Briley** will be the guest speaker, and his topic will be "Day to Day Wisdom". An outline will be handed out at the beginning of class, and he will provide questions and other material that will be used for the following two weeks for discussion in our individual adult classes. **Dr. Briley** teaches Old Testament and Hebrew courses at Lipscomb University. He currently serves as dean of the College of Bible and Ministry. He is also one of the pulpit ministers for the Natchez Trace Church of Christ and is involved with mission work in Brazil. Terry received his B.A. in Biblical Languages from Lipscomb in 1978. He received the M.Phil (1986) and Ph.D. (1990) in Hebraic and Cognate Studies from Hebrew Union College. He has published a two-volume commentary on Isaiah for College Press and is one of the editors for their Old Testament commentary series. He and his wife, Teri, have two sons, Nathan and Daniel.

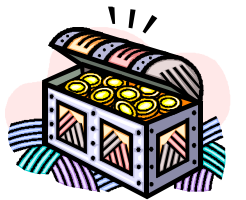
