Our 5th Sunday in August will all us to honor **Andy Flatt** for his 17 years of directing our singing and an opportunity to purchase Bibles with our 5th Sunday contribution. Andy will be leading singing at all of our services that day, and we will have a special reception to honor him and his family after our evening service.

Our elders are pleased to announce: "After considerable prayer, discussion and research, the elders have decided to direct the entirety of those funds to a special opportunity to **place the Word of God in the hands of the people of Myanmar** (formerly Burma). Following the devastation of a recent cyclone, Christian believers working within this largely Buddhist nation of 50 million have reported a noticeable increase in requests for Bibles. To seize this special opportunity, the elders are planning to partner with others to fund the printing and distribution of thousands of New Testaments in the native language of the people of Myanmar. Remarkably, **every dollar given by those of us at Brentwood Hills will provide a New Testament to this effort**. That means if we continue the giving pattern already established for 2008, we will be able to place at least 50,000 New Testaments in the country of Myanmar. Because we believe in the power of God's Word to transform human lives, the potential for good and for spreading God's Kingdom that this represents is self-evident. We sincerely ask for your support and full participation. Please begin now to pray and plan for this special contribution."
