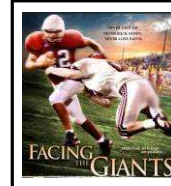

2. Secure the top and bottom with a rubber band.
3. Remember to include an envelope with a **\$5.00 check** payable to **Magi Project** to handle shipping.
4. Place your wrapped completed box in the Magi Project bin in the foyer by **October 5th**.
