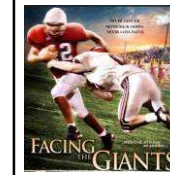

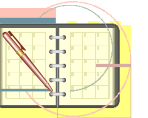
### Family Fun on the Farm - Saturday, October 11
