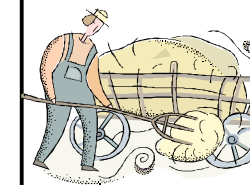


### Fourth Grade Family Picnic at the Park this Sunday

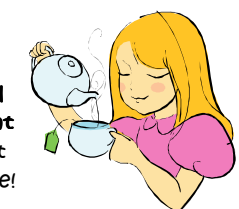
### Third Grade Fall Family Hayride/Chili Supper Sunday, November 9 4 p.m.
