A WORD FROM WALT

"How many stones are on the wall in the front of the Brentwood Hills' Auditorium?"

A few years ago, two Brentwood Hills members were talking in my presence, and that exact question was asked. The almost instant reply was actually another question: "Do you want the total for the left side, the right side, or for both sides?" Both men then turned to me with smiles on their faces and said - "We have to do something during your sermons."

I recalled that true story this past Wednesday night during POWER as we read the following verse from I Peter 2:

... you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house ...

Let me ask two questions:

Which stone on the wall in the front of the Auditorium is the most important? Because each stone is unique and fills a vital spot in the wall, I don't think it's possible to identify one as more important than any of the others.

If just one of those stones was missing, would it be noticed? Of course it would be noticed. Furthermore, you can be sure that plans would be in place soon, if not already, to find that stone and repair the wall.

Now, a few obvious parallels:

Every member of God's family is unique and fills a vital spot in the "spiritual house" that He is in the process of building! Even though Satan attacks us by either inflating or deflating our egos - wanting us to think we are either more important than others or not needed at all - God knows that all of us are priceless and necessary!

If and when just one of the "living stones" is missing, you can be sure that God notices it - even if we do not. Furthermore, we can know that He already has a plan in action to find that stone, repair it if necessary, and put it back into its vital place.

- Several personal questions:**
- Are you more likely to have an inflated or deflated view of your own significance?
 - Do you realize that in God's plan you have a vital role in what He is doing in the world today?
 - Do you realize that everyone around us is just as important in God's eyes and in His plan?
 - As you look around today, who is missing?
 - As members of God's family, what responsibility do we have regarding "living stones" that are out of place?
 - If necessary, would you be willing to be used by God to help "find" that priceless person?

HONDURAS 2009

Airline tickets have been reserved, and we are making plans for our 2009 Mission Trip to Honduras. Last year's trip took several turns after the airport in Tegucigalpa was closed for several months. However, the airport is re-opened, and we will be able to fly back into the capital city.

This year we have extended our trip by one day and to help save money on flights we are splitting into two groups---travel on day a part. We have tickets reserved for the first group from Tuesday, July 14th-Tuesday, July 21st and our second group from Wednesday, July 15th-Wednesday, July 22nd. Our applications will allow you to select a first choice, and we will try to honor those requests. We have to release tickets after April 1st or pay a major penalty. That means we must have applications and deposits in by April 1, 2009.

The cost of the trip this year will be \$1,100. Due to some increase in airfare, hotel, food and the extra day of the trip (seven nights) the cost of the trip has increased slightly over last year. Applications will soon be posted on line at www.brentwoodhills.org and they can be picked up in the foyer.

We will be building houses, distributing food, working at the JMA Clinic, with Baxter, the Kennedy church and other special projects during this trip.
