#### Here are just a very few examples:

On the Monday after the storm, more than 200 volunteers were packing boxes and loading trucks at Disaster Relief to provide essential food and supplies for those most affected by this devastating storm. Over these past two weeks at least 500 volunteers have worked to send 25 truck loads of supplies to a dozen different cities

Last Saturday, Brent High organized a group of almost 30 volunteers – primarily student-athletes – who went from Nashville to Paducah to assist in the massive clean-up operation. On Sunday, Jerry Cover organized a similar group of 36 volunteers – with several guys from the Back 40 Outreach, some from the Men's Ministry and three young people from the middle school youth group (see picture below).

Both of these relief brigades left for Kentucky long before daylight and spent each day lifting, dragging, pulling, loading, unloading, piling and burning thousands of limbs and trees, and doing massive cleanup. On Sunday, Ryan Ezell brought his tractor and front loader for some heavy-duty lifting, and the sound of roaring chainsaws could be heard across the countryside.

Many of the relief efforts in the area are being coordinated by the Lone Oak Church of Christ in Paducah. Folks from Lone Oak provided both food and encouragement to these brigades. Les Sternburg, who is coordinating Lone Oak's relief efforts, expressed their feelings this way, "We just can't tell you how much we appreciate you helping us, and how much it really means when people show

There is much more to be done, and these neighbors desperately need our help! Brigades are scheduled to go from Brentwood Hills the next two Sundays, February 22 and March 1. And, of course, they are packing boxes and loading trucks every week at Disaster Relief. Be listening for announcements with specific details.
