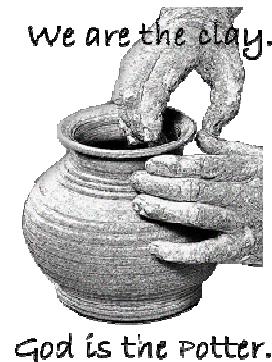

Houston, we've got a problem.

Brentwood Hills, we've got a problem. This morning during Family Matters, I will take a few minutes to address the issue. But first let me set the stage.

We are overcrowded. This morning several of adult

classes are moving to new locations, and we will continue to have three classes in the Family Life Center. We are also using two storage rooms in the FLC for class rooms. Every available space is being used. For our children--their time of fellowship and free play in the FLC is very important.

However, we have a problem.

The problem is not space, or that we offer free play. On Wednesday nights many of us love to eat and fellowship, and we let our children run and play during and after the meal. After classes and worship times the children run to the Family Life Center to play. This is part of their development within our family.

Along the way--balls go flying everywhere hitting people, walls are knocked down, equipment is damaged, and dangerous games are played as the young people explore behind the walls.

Wednesday night...someone took a marker and did some drawing on the FLC wall and the portable walls and destroyed some of the insulation around one of the doors.

Someone is going to get hurt unless we address the real issue: Supervision. As parents, we have a responsibility. As teachers, volunteers and staff, we have a responsibility to correct our young people and to help enforce our rules and guidelines. We need some help, and it starts with us as parents.

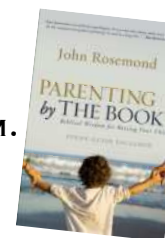
