A WORD FROM WALT Woodbine Family

Woodbine Family is making an impact in the community of Woodbine (Nolensville road/ Thompson lane). Over the past 5 years this effort has transformed from a group of college students leading a few children, into now a congregation of multiple ages, races, and varying income brackets, worshipping and working together. Attendance on Sundays averages around 55. About 35 of these would not attend another church if it were not for Woodbine. On Wednesdays we average 85. Of this group we believe 55 would not attend Bible class if it were not offered at Woodbine. The exciting opportunity which we give to BHCC is the avenue of service to this "inner city" community. We do currently have one full time minister, Michael Peters, as well as a part-time girl's minster, Dee Dee Hatchell. In February our teens attended Winterfest and last week Michael took a group on a "Spring Break Road Trip" to visit 2 area universities. In late May most all of our kids will enjoy a week at Camp Sycamore Creek. Several area families worship with us consistently. It is a great measure of growth for us when parents are led to the Lord through their children. The struggles of our families are not new and will never cease entirely. However, with the support of BHCC, Woodbine strives to be an oasis of Christ's hope and safety in an often dark world. Thanks so much for being a part of this ministry.

The fifth Sunday funds are needed by Woodbine to fund operations for the remainder of 2009 since our stewardship plan had to reduce the regular funding received on a monthly basis.

Grandview

Fifth Sunday Opportunity:
On Sunday, March 29th, our entire contribution will be dedicated to support evangelistic efforts in the Nashville area. More specifically, the funds will be used to continue our efforts at Grandview and Woodbine. For those of you not familiar with these ministries, we offer the following highlights:

Iglesia de Cristo en Grandview:
We are beginning our fourth year at Grandview, and God continues to bless this ministry. There have been more than 35 baptisms since Brentwood Hills assumed leadership of this effort. The greatest number of converts has come through our English and Computer classes that are offered at the building each week. In addition, our minister, Roberto Santiago is involved in Bible studies, home visits and spiritual counseling. Although Ginger works full time at Lipscomb, she has taken a leadership role in working with the children's classes, and her efforts have generated a continuous need for more teachers. Grandview has also become a "center" of co-ordination for many ministers of Spanish speaking congregations in Middle Tennessee. Efforts are currently underway to provide literature to thousands of homes in the area to share Jesus with the community. This is in addition to the hundreds of Bibles that have been placed in the hands of individuals who have visited the Grandview facility. On a daily basis other needs of the members and community are met to include food, clothing and assistance with medical needs.

Without additional funding, the evangelistic efforts with our Spanish speaking brother and sisters will be severely curtailed. Currently, our stewardship plan only funds the operating expenses for Grandview to the early part of the third quarter of 2009. There are many lives being touched by this ministry, and through your generosity and God's will, we will continue to support these efforts for many years.

EASTER EGG HUNT


