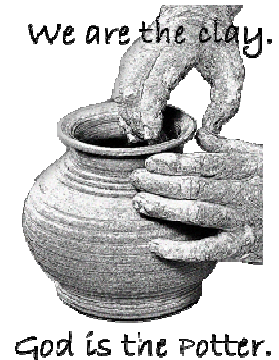

## CAMP SHILOH 2009

This year will be the 8<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that Brentwood Hills will have the opportunity to work at Camp Shiloh to improve their camp facilities in preparation for their summer camp. Camp Shiloh is based in New York City and is supported by congregations in the New York area. During the year, they host teens on a weekly basis for Bible study, provide tutoring in some local public schools, and then offer the camping experience for the students in the summer. Their primary targeted groups are students from under-resourced areas of New York (Bronx, Brooklyn) and Stanford, CT.

Brentwood Hills has been instrumental in making several camp improvements, including both new buildings and improvements to existing buildings. This past year, a significant milestone was accomplished at the camp when a new Celebration Center was erected on site. The center is awaiting groups of volunteers to complete the interior and prepare the center for use by the camp. This center is designed to serve as a multi-purpose facility, which fills a real need, as it will provide a much needed kitchen facility and a common area for many activities.

We need volunteers willing to give a week this summer to help with this work. We plan to leave Nashville on Sat., May 30 and return on Sat., June 6. We have flown to Albany in recent years and then taken rentals from there to the camp, which is about a 2-hour drive. We need individuals who may have skills for construction, those who are great at following directions from others, cooks, and all-purpose workers. No one will go without being used in valuable ways. We welcome your interest and covet your participation.
