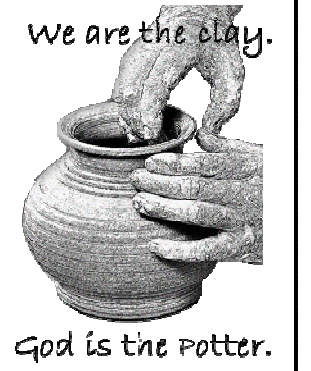

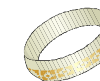
### LADS TO LEADERS
