A WORD FROM WALT How do you spell FAMILY?

Families are extremely important at Brentwood Hills! This afternoon's parenting seminar, led by nationally-acclaimed author John Rosemond, is only one example of the priority this congregation places on families, along with the multiple showings of the powerful movie *Fireproof* next weekend.

But how do you spell FAMILY? Acrostics are popular at Brentwood Hills, so let me give you one – six words that help to 'spell' what a family really is.

However, this is only the beginning. Tonight we'll share another half-dozen 'family-defining' words for each of these six letters. You may even want to spend a few minutes thinking about this before tonight, and we'll compare lists at 6:00 p.m. For now, here is one word for each of the six letters:

FAITH – There is real wisdom in the familiar phrase, "The family that prays together stays together" and in God's words, "Unless the Lord builds the house, its builders labor in vain." From the beginning, marriage and the family were top priority for God and established by Him long before any government and thousands of years before the church. Nothing is more vital to the success of our families than for there to be an authentic and growing relationship with the Lord! ALWAYS – In his book Secrets of Strong Families, Nick Stinnett wrote that interviewers who met with thousands of healthy families repeatedly heard the same phrase – "We always ..." For example, "We always go to Grandmothers' for Thanksgiving. We always make chili when it snows. We always go the beach in the summer." Traditions and memories are priceless building blocks in our

 $\underline{\text{MEN}}$ – I realize that 'Mother' might be a more popular choice for the 'M' – and it will certainly be one of the words listed tonight. However, I am challenged by these words from II Chronicles 20:13 – "All the men of Judah, with their wives and children … stood before the Lord." Judah was facing a crisis. So is America, and so is the American family. The women and children were certainly important, but God notes that the men were those who took the lead in standing before the Lord. It worked then, and it will work now!

<u>INSPIRATION</u> – We live in a world filled with too many people ready to criticize and discourage. May our goal be just the opposite in our families! I love the phrase from the old song *Home on the Range* – 'where never is heard a discouraging word, and the skies are not cloudy all day.' What a great description that would be for our families!

<u>LAUGHTER</u> – Love is the obvious "L" word (and will also be mentioned tonight), but laughter is a priceless ingredient as well. The Bible says "a cheerful heart is good medicine," and that is certainly applicable to the health of our families. Families that not only pray together but also play together are truly blessed!

<u>YIELD</u> – "Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ" is the phrase Paul uses to introduce his section on 'family' in Ephesians – chapters 5 & 6. It is good for us to learn as children how to 'give' and 'forgive.' The best and safest place to discover that "it's really not all about me" is in the loving and unconditional environment of family. And of course, the most important decision we ever make, and the most valuable decision for any family member, is to yield our lives to God!

All of these characteristics, and the others that we'll mention tonight, apply both to our own families and to our church family. How blessed we are to be in God's Family at Brentwood Hille!


