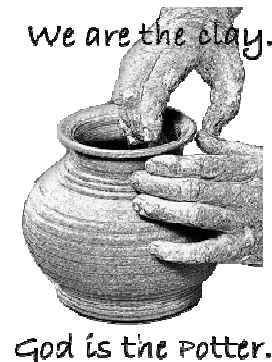

JONATHAN'S JOURNEY

God blessed us with a great week of weather. Thank you for all of your prayers and notes of encouragement. The White Bluff Post Office thought it was Christmas because of the high volume of mail!

Nearly 200 campers and staff have enjoyed this week of experiencing God and the Sea. We have charted the course, and we are ready for our senior campers to set sail on Sunday. This Sunday we have registration at 2:30 p.m., a family picnic (bring your own supper) at 5:00 p.m., and our evening worship at 6:00 p.m. Among all the fun and excitement at camp this week, I have also been keeping a close watch on the political situation in Honduras. This morning our elders will share more about the present situation in Honduras and our decision to cancel this year's trip to Honduras.

Cancelling the trip was what we had to do. As much as we are disappointed, we had to consider the safety of our brothers and sisters in Honduras. Here is an email I got from Ronald Million about the situation in Honduras:

Dear hermano, your thoughts to cancel the trip is the best recommendation that you gave to our Elders. This morning I went to Tegucigalpa to visit some Government offices with two boys from Jovenes. We had to return to el Zamorano early, because there are many strikes in Tegucigalpa. Some supporting the new president, and others asking the return of Manuel Zelaya. The situation continue sad and dangerous. Sad, because a lot of people is suffering, the food beginning to stock up. We can't walk and drive safe. The stores and restaurants must to close at 8:00 p.m., because everybody must to be in their houses at 9:00 p.m (curfew) until 6:00 a.m Nahum, German, and Rony are agree that is the best that the group from Brentwood Hills no come this year. I support them. I has been very worried thinking in all of you.

I told Daysi that I love to see Brentwood Hills group every year in Honduras, but this year we prefer that all of you be safe in your home. Honduras right now is ne safe country.

The most important for me is to knoe that all of you will be fine. Just we need to be very prudents, and our Elders are very wise men. On another hand we are very worried for our brother German, as you know he was in the army, and the new President is trying to call him to the army. Please keep him in your prayers. President Zelaya advertised or declared from the ONU that he will return on Thursday. On Thursday will be another terrible day for us. Please keep us in your prayers.

Right now i have in my houses some young men, they no want to go to the Army. They are hiding in my house.

In Limoncillo we need food for the next days for the people and others communities. In Jovenes en Camino we are preparing some food for the next two weeks. No Internet this morning.

Love you brother. And we miss you. Say hello all my Elders and my family from Brentwood Hills. Your son, Ronald Millon

Thank you for your prayers for camp and for Honduras. We do worship a POWERFUL God. He has been busy this week shaping and molding us, as we continue our Journey to the SON! jfs
