**A WORD FROM WALT**

**Peter said to Jesus,  
"Lord, it is good for us to be here.  
If you wish, I will put up three shelters –  
one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah."  
Matthew 17:4**

Peter's reaction is very understandable. Along with James and John, he was with Jesus on a high mountain where these three apostles had just witnessed an incredible conversation between Jesus, Moses and Elijah. In more ways than one this was truly a 'mountain-top experience' and Peter obviously felt it would be wonderful to extend it – at least for a while if not indefinitely.

For the 23<sup>rd</sup> year the Brentwood Hills Christian Camp has truly been a 'mountain-top experience' for hundreds of people in this congregation – both campers and staff.
