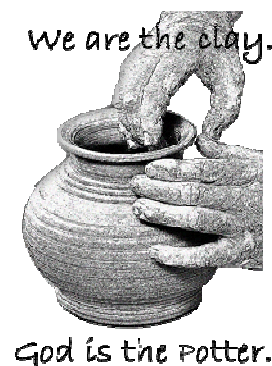

**A WORD FROM WALT**

**Facts ... Feelings ... Faith  
What controls our lives?**

One of the "sea stories" at camp this year illustrated the 'Power of Prayer' as the disciples cried out to Jesus while He was sleeping during a violent storm in their boat on the Sea of Galilee (Luke 8:22-25). This same story reminds us of the choice we all make daily between three significant questions:

- Are we going to allow 'facts' to control our lives?
- Will we allow 'feelings' to control our lives?
- Are we willing to allow 'faith' to control our lives?

The 'facts' are often obvious and undeniable. In this story "a squall came down on the lake, so that the boat was being swamped, and they were in great danger." Financial facts, medical facts, employment facts and legal facts are just some of the means by which our lives can too often seem 'swamped ... and in great danger.'

Feelings often follow the facts. Even though Jesus assured them in this story that they would 'go over,' they were now convinced they were about to 'go under' - "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" Who among us can deny ever 'feeling' like we were 'going to drown' as we faced some of the 'facts' challenging our lives? I am confident most of us - if not all of us - can relate to those feelings, fears and frustrations on a very personal level.

"Where is your faith?" After responding to their plea and calming the storm with His voice, Jesus used this penetrating question to take the spotlight off the facts and their feelings - and He challenged His disciples, as He challenges us, to focus on Him.

In his book *Crazy Love*, Francis Chan conservatively estimates that God has created more than 350 Billion galaxies - just one of numerous facts Chan provides to illustrate God's awesome reality. WOW! Regardless of the facts, our God can handle it! When our faith is focused on Him - we can too!
