A WORD FROM WALT
"... there are five Sundays in August"

One day this past week I was talking with friends who only occasionally visit Brentwood Hills. Our discussion was interrupted with what initially might have seemed to be an unrelated comment – "I realized the other day that there are five Sundays in August."

Actually, though we had not been discussing Sundays in August or even Brentwood Hills, I immediately knew the "story" behind this comment. 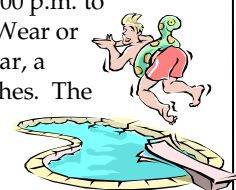
ADOPT A CLASSROOM
