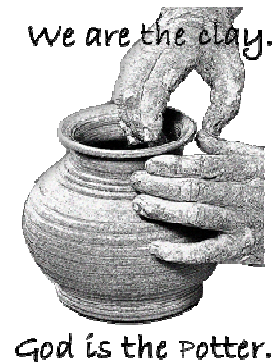

A WORD FROM WALT

*It is for your good that I am going away.
Unless I go away, the Counselor (Holy Spirit)
will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.
John 16:7*

In view of this promise from Jesus, given to His disciples on the night before His crucifixion, consider this paragraph from Francis Chan's new book, *Forgotten God*:

When the disciples heard those words from Jesus two thousand years ago, I'm sure it was hard for them to grasp. How could it be better to trade a human Jesus – a man they could talk and eat and laugh with – for a Spirit they couldn't physically see? Thousands of years later, I think most of us would also choose a physical Jesus over an invisible Spirit. But what do we do with the fact that Jesus says it is better for His followers to have the Holy Spirit? Do we believe Him? If so, do our lives reflect that belief?

On that fateful night, Jesus' disciples were facing a challenging and uncertain future. Several thousand years later, His disciples often still face futures that seem very similar. Yet, then and now, Jesus is always very aware of exactly what His disciples need, and He makes all the necessary arrangements in advance – and in abundance!

The "gift of the Holy Spirit," promised along with forgiveness to those who repent and are baptized into Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38), is what Jesus is describing. However, there may be some who can even quote these familiar words – *Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit* – without a true awareness or appreciation of the practical value of what Jesus is promising.
