**A WORD FROM WALT**

*Thunder, Lightning, and Grace*

In challenging financial times, when people who want to succeed aren't even sure they'll survive, God's message in II Corinthians 8 and 9 is especially pertinent and helpful. This Sunday and next we'll take a look at those two chapters, using these insightful words from Randy Alcorn's book *The Treasure Principle* to help set the stage:

*The Macedonian Christians understood the joy of giving: "Out of the most severe trial, their overflowing joy and their extreme poverty welled up in rich generosity" (II Corinthians 8:2).*

*How do "severe trial," "overflowing joy," "extreme poverty," and "rich generosity" all fit together in one verse? Giving isn't a luxury of the rich. It's a privilege of the poor. I've discovered that impoverished Christians find no greater joy than in giving.*

*The Macedonian Christians refused to let hard circumstances keep them from joy: "They urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the saints" (v. 4). They had to plead, presumably because Paul and others were telling them that their poverty exempted them from giving.*

*These early Christians were dirt-poor but came up with every reason they could to give. They begged for the privilege of giving! What a contrast to us, who have so much more than they had but manage to come up with endless justifications for not giving!*

*My friend Dixie Fraley told me, "We're most like God when we're giving." Gaze upon Christ long enough, and you'll become more of a giver. Give long enough, and you'll become more like Christ.*

*Our giving is a reflexive response to the grace of God in our lives. It doesn't come out of our altruism or philanthropy - it comes out of the transforming work of Christ in us. This grace is the action; our giving is the reaction. We give because He first gave to us. The greatest passage on giving in all Scripture ends not with "Congratulations for your generosity," but "Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!" (II Corinthians 9:15).*

*As thunder follows lightning, giving follows grace. When God's grace touches you, you can't help but respond with generous giving. And as the Macedonians knew, giving is simply the overflow of joy.*

### ENCOUNTERING GOD THROUGH THE PSALMS

From Jon Lowrance...From March through May, our adult classes will be studying several Psalms. This Old Testament book has influenced the world and declares to us the love, faithfulness, and holiness of our Heavenly Father. Psalms have influenced many of our worship songs, and verses from Psalms are the most quoted of the Bible. Reading and studying the Psalms can deeply influence our daily meditation, life, and worship. Deuteronomy 11 tells us to fix God's words in our hearts and minds, binding them as symbols on our hands and teaching them to our children. If we obey this command with our spring quarter study, we will be blessed! God's word can keep us directed on our Journey of Light and Love to the Son!

To begin our series for this quarter, we will start with Psalm 2. This psalm was considered a royal psalm because of its focus on the anointing of a new Davidic king. Some believe it was read during the coronation of a new king, but little evidence exists to support this. However, some scholars believe that the intent lies within the framework of God's promises to David and his descendents (2 Samuel 7:5-16). This coming Sunday our adult classes will explore this psalm and its meaning to the Jewish community and its implications for us in the 21st century.

Each week you can access the questions and listen to the Psalms being read by John Young—just visit the BHCC website. We will demonstrate this for you during the Family Matters this morning.

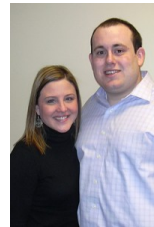
