# A WORD FROM WALT

take up twelve stones from the middle of the Jordan...put them down at... the place where you stay tonight...These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever. Joshua 4:3,7

Memorial Day was established years ago as a day to remember those who've given their lives in service to our country. However, the concept of "memorials" is one that God used (and still uses) to help His people

One great example comes from the story of Joshua. The Israelites were preparing to cross the Jordan River into the Promised Land. Joshua's final instructions included the selection of twelve men who would each select a stone from the middle of the river bed. These stones were to be carried out of the river and stacked in a pile at their camp for the night. From then on, those stones would provide a very tangible reminder of the deliverance God had provided by bringing the Israelites miraculously through the Jordan.

Imagine the faith-building stories parents were able to tell when their children would ask, "Why are those stones stacked up in the middle of our camp?" The door would be wide open for them to share with their children some of the amazing things God had done and could do.

Imagine the encouragement available to any discouraged man or woman who was wondering whether God would help with challenges they were facing. Even one glance at the pile of stones would quickly and clearly remind them that God is able to handle any obstacle or any challenge no matter how impossible it might seem to be.

What "piles of stones" do we have in our lives? Are we able to tell our children any stories from our lives or experience - in addition to the stories from the Bible - that illustrate what God is capable and willing to do for us today? When we're discouraged or facing tough challenges, are there stories or experiences we can recall, in addition to the promises from His Word, that clearly remind us that our God is still alive and well?

Perhaps on this Memorial Day weekend we'd all benefit from spending at least a few minutes "gathering some stones" - thinking about some of those specific ways God has demonstrated His power in our lives - or in the lives of those close to us.

As the familiar song says, "it will surprise you what the Lord has done."


