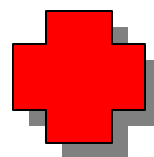

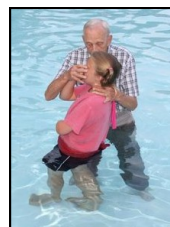

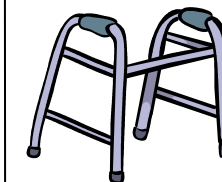
MISSING SOMETHING?
