Here are the 5 easy steps to getting involved with the Magi Project:

1. Pick up an info sheet in the foyer which will provide you with detailed instructions for completing a Magi Box.
2. Choose an age and gender category, and start shopping!
3. Fill a shoe box or small plastic container with toys, school supplies, books, toiletries, clothes, candy, and even a personal note or picture.
4. Bring your completed box to the BHCC building no later than **this Wednesday, September 29.**
5. PRAY for the precious children who will receive these boxes. God's love for them is infinite, and He has incredible plans for their lives.

What an incredible sight it would be to see hundreds of these boxes stacked up in the foyer – and to know that God has already picked out a special child to receive each and every box. Thank you for your generosity and your servant hearts! Don't forget to pick up an info sheet in the foyer!

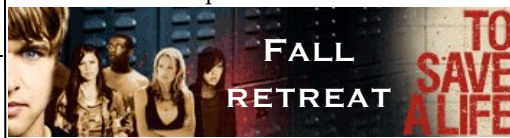
