A WORD FROM WALT

The Longest Day

"The Longest Day" was a 1962 award-winning movie starring John Wayne, Henry Fonda and others – a movie that told the story of the Normandy Invasion in June 1944 (D-Day). But this article is not about that movie – or any movie. It's about the longest day.

The longest day every year is that day in the fall when the time "falls back" to Standard Time rather than Daylight Savings Time. Even though most of us typically sleep right through it, one of those hours in the night gets a "do over," and once a year we have a 25-hour day.

More than dozen years ago Jonathan decided that it would be a great thing for this church family to spend a day in prayer – an entire day every year. But what day during the year should it be?

If you're going to spend one day each year devoted entirely to prayer, what better day could be chosen than the longest day?

Therefore, one of the many wonderful traditions at Brentwood Hills is the 25 Hours of Prayer every fall on Time Change Weekend.

As you know, it begins next Saturday morning, November 6, at 8:00 a.m. and continues without interruption until 8:00 a.m. Sunday morning – 25 hours later. Although anyone and everyone is encouraged to "pray without ceasing" wherever you are and whenever you can that entire day, a non-stop prayer meeting will be in progress the entire time in the Elders Conference Room at Brentwood Hills, and you are always welcome to come by – for a few minutes or a few hours (or any amount of time in between).

During these 25 hours, everyone in the Brentwood Hills family is specifically prayed for by name, and every ministry, missionary, program and activity is taken by prayer before God's Throne. In addition, countless prayer requests – some received on written notes, some on the white board in the foyer (check out Jonathan's Journey for more details) and others submitted online – are included in the prayers.

Today's Sunday School lesson focuses on the power of prayer – which has the potential of being much more powerful than any of the weapons used at Normandy or in any warfare of man (II Corinthians 10:3-5). How exciting that as a church family we can spend the longest day next weekend implementing this powerful weapon God provides for us!
