When Chet speaks, his message focuses on choosing to be happy, the incredible value of life, and how to overcome insurmountable odds.

Chet graduated magna cum laude from the University of North Texas in 2002 with a Bachelor of Arts degree, majoring in Radio, Television and Film production. In addition to speaking, he is an experienced worship leader and also owns his own travel agency. Chet, his wife Joni, and their daughter Hannah live in the Dallas/Fort Worth area.
