If you would like to pray, just leave the auditorium during the invitation song and come to the prayer room. At other times, feel free to call the office to arrange a meeting.

## A WORD FROM WALT

*Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. Mark 1:35*

Jesus obviously understood the value of beginning His day spending time alone with His Father. If we've not already established that "habit," this is a good time of the year to consider it. With an early sunrise the next several months, we can follow Jesus' example without having to get up while it is still dark.

Here are several simple, practical and probably familiar suggestions, each of which can be done in a short period of time (15 minutes or less) and alone (without needing to involve or disturb anyone else):

#### Read Scripture

Allow God to start the conversation. Let God speak to you. Rather than reading randomly, use a system or a plan – many good ones are available.

#### Pray

Talk to God about what He has just told you in Scripture. Use prayers in the Bible as an outline for your prayers (e.g. Luke 11:2-4). Develop and use a prayer list.

#### Keep a Journal

Write down what God is teaching you – both through His Word and through your daily experiences.

#### Memorize Scripture

Select verses that are especially helpful or meaningful and commit them to memory. Use index cards to make 'flash cards' and keep the verses with you for frequent review. Memorizing a verse makes it possible to meditate on the verse (Psalm 1:2).

#### Use a Daily Devotional

Wonderful resources are available to help focus our attention each day – such as *Jesus Calling, Power for Today, My Utmost for His Highest* and many others.

#### Read Great Books

We can "walk with the wise" (Proverbs 13:20) by reading books that strengthen our faith – and many excellent options are available. Visit the Brentwood Hills Library and spend some time at a local Christian bookstore (e.g. 21st Century Christian).
