A WORD FROM WALT

In my mind, summer 'officially' begins on Memorial Day and ends on Labor Day. In between are three of the most exciting months of the entire year. That is certainly true here at Brentwood Hills. In addition to the regular opportunities we share throughout the year, the summer months have a number of special blessings. Here are a few of the 'signs of summer':

Summer Interns - This summer we welcome two incredible young people who will be vital members of the Brentwood Hills family for the next three months - Lindsay and Jeremiah. Although their primary focus will be with our teens - under the leadership of Robbie and Nancy—their presence among us will bless everyone. We are glad they are here!

Mission Trips - Hundreds from the BHCC family will be involved in mission trips this summer. Right now we have a group at Camp Shiloh in New York, and over the coming weeks groups will travel to a domestic violence shelter in Birmingham, to Nashville Inner City Camp, and another group will head to Camp Shiloh. Also, more than 60 will be headed to Honduras for that annual life-changing experience.

Nashville Workcamp - In one week more than 350 teens and adults from several states will meet in Nashville to paint houses in the name of Jesus! Robbie coordinates this entire effort, which will involve more than 30 from Brentwood Hills. It's an amazing demonstration of love and service, and if you have room in your home to house a couple of these hard working teens you will be blessed!

Vacation Bible School - We are just two weeks away from what may be the largest and most exciting Brentwood Hills VBS yet! Prepare to go back in time and around the world as hundreds of volunteers will be helping us experience an interactive and inspiring tour of Nazareth in Bible times. And since VBS will again take place at night all of us can be here - and our friends, too!

Brentwood Hills Christian Camp - It's hard to believe that this will be the 25th year of camp at Brentwood Hills. Almost 400 participate 'full-time' at Camp Leatherwood, but many more than that are involved in one way or another supporting one of the most important activities of the entire Brentwood Hills year. On Sunday mornings in Children's Worship I will often ask the children: "What are the two things we want all of them to do when they get a little older?" 
