A WORD FROM WALT

Last Sunday, in a combined Sunday School class that concluded our three -month Holy Spirit study, numerous people responded to the question, "What have we learned so far about the Holy Spirit?" The comments that followed filled almost an hour and were both inspiring and challenging.

These comments from Eric Grogan provide a good example:

Lamar Bowman was our teacher in the Believer's Class. The entire class was very excited and engaged during the entire study and our discussions were very open-minded. A seeker's attitude was pervasive throughout the course. These first five listed were lessons I learned, and the remaining four were from discussions with Jim Loden –

- 1. My eyes are now more open to the things that God, through the Spirit, is doing around me and through me.
- I can no longer put limitations on what the Spirit will do in this day and time. God will accomplish His will through the Spirit, in His time, and in His way.
- 3. I want sin out of my life and the lives of the believers around me so we can be used by the Spirit, in greater ways, to accomplish God's will for His glory.
- I will no longer criticize believers around me who worship differently or at buildings with different names on them for their views about the Spirit. I have stopped limiting God's activity in their lives, in my mind, so He may receive the glory He deserves and I can see Him more clearly.
- 5. I am no longer using the term "providence of God" when I should reference the Holy Spirit, who is an equal member of the Godhead three in one.
- 6. I am going to stop trying to let God work for me and allow God, through the Spirit, to work through me.
- 7. The Spirit will manifest Himself in my life and in the lives of others at differing strengths at different times, depending on God's needs. Samson's life is a prime example. This may be because I am limiting him by my lifestyle or simply because he is waiting for His time.
- 8. Our talents are different than the gifts of the Spirit. We should use our talents for the Lord but only God gives gifts of the Spirit.
- My eyes have been opened to how many times the 'Holy Spirit' is mentioned in scripture and I am looking at the New Testament in a whole new 'light'.

Thanks to the elders, teachers and all my brothers and sisters in the Lord who have challenged me throughout this course.
