A WORD FROM WALT

Just in case you haven't read it, or want to read it again ...

Nearly 60 from Brentwood Hills are on a mission in Tegucigalpa, Honduras this morning, and we are in middle of a summer-long study of *Radical*. In view of those facts, this abridged excerpt from that book (pp 80-81) is certainly worth reading ... or re-reading:

Let me introduce you to Jeff, a businessman who climbed the ladder of success, only to realize that success in the kingdom of God involves moving down, not up. I'll let him tell his story in his own words:

My career has been more successful than I ever anticipated it could be. I have been incredibly blessed ... dream home ... BMW ... beach house ... great vacations! But somehow something was missing from my life, and I couldn't figure out what it was. I have been a Christian since I was seven years old ... but I had replaced seeking the Lord with pursuing stuff and success.

Then something happened last year that changed my life. I stood in a city dump in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. I saw men, women and children who were living in a dump where they scoured for food and shelter. Humbled by the reality of parents raising their kids in a dump, I reached my breaking point when I saw a woman eight months pregnant walk by me, looking for food. I couldn't decide which was worse - the fact that the baby was conceived in a dump or that it was going to be born there. In the middle of this scene, God asked me, "What are you going to do with what I have given you? How are you going to use your influence, your leadership, and your resources in the world around you?"

For the first time, Jeff realized that God had a purpose for his life that was greater than the pursuit of the next and bigger thing. So Jeff decided to walk away from the American dream. He still runs his business and makes a lot of money, but not to make much for himself. He and a couple of other guys have begun a ministry that works with local churches around the world to provide clean water in communities where thousands are dying every day of preventable waterborne diseases. Together they are discovering that God is committed to providing abundant resources in support of those who are living according to His purpose.
