### Family Matters and Prayer

## A WORD FROM WALT

Last Sunday we read this verse from Acts 2:41:

*Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.*

I asked the question:

*Has anyone ever seen or even heard about another occasion when three thousand people were baptized into Christ on the same day?*

Frankly, I did not expect anyone to say that had, and no one has come forth yet to change that expectation. However, Andy Flatt did provide an interesting perspective:

*It looks like the world's population at the time of Christ was in the 200,000,000 range - about 1/35<sup>th</sup> of today's global population. So in Acts 2, 3000 is an impressive number by itself. However, in comparison with today's population, 3,000 on Pentecost equates to more than 100,000 today!*

To some of us it might seem extremely "radical" to think in terms of even 100 baptisms on the same day - not to mention 1,000 or 100,000. But several questions may be worth asking:

- *Is the Gospel of Christ as powerful and as pertinent as it was 2,000 years ago? Of course it is!*
- *Are there hundreds of thousands of people alive today who have not surrendered their lives to Jesus Christ? Of course there are! In fact, very conservative estimates indicate that more than four billion people are alive today who have no connection whatsoever with Jesus Christ.*

It's easy to get caught up and even overwhelmed with numbers. However, it's important to remember a few very simple but important truths:

- *God is the One who "adds to His church" - it's not up to us but to Him!*
- *However, He wants believers today to do what the believers in Acts did. Here are just a few examples:*
  - *They could not keep quiet about what Jesus meant to them (4:20)*
  - *They were filled with and depended on the Holy Spirit (4:31)*
  - *They found ways to bring glory to God in any and every situation (8:4)*

When we do God's work in God's way we can anticipate God's results:

*And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved. (Acts 2:47)*
